

2. Call the front office at 317/789-1621 announcing your arrival. Stay in your car and a staff member will escort your student.

We do not release students during the last 30 minutes of school for safety reasons as busses are arriving. If you need to pick up early, please be sure it is before 2:00 (1:30 on Wednesdays) and follow the above procedure.


